CHAPTER 5 GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AGAINST FIRE

SECTION 501 OPEN BURNING AND INCINERATORS

501.1 Bonfires and Outdoor Rubbish Fires

501.1.1 No person shall kindle or maintain any bonfire or rubbish fire or authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintained without a permit or other proper authorization. During construction or demolition of buildings or structures, no waste materials or rubbish shall be disposed of by burning on the premises or in the immediate vicinity without having obtained a permit or other proper authorization.

501.1.2 No person shall kindle or maintain any bonfire or rubbish fire or authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintained on any private land unless the location is not less than 50 ft (15.2 m) from any structure and adequate provision is made to prevent fire from spreading within 50 ft (15.2 m) of any structure, or the fire is contained in an approved waste burner located safely, not less than 15 ft (4.6 m) from any structure.

501.1.3 Bonfires and rubbish fires shall be constantly attended by a competent person until such fire is extinguished. Such person shall have a garden hose connected to the water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment readily available for use.

501.1.4 The fire official may prohibit any or all bonfires and outdoor rubbish fires when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous.
