CODE OF CONDUCT

- ANY violation of the Code of Conduct or violation of directives by staff members may result in suspension from recreation facilities and/or activities.
- ANY expression of physical or verbal abuse to any staff member or user of the facility will result in immediate suspension.
- NO smoking and/or use of any tobacco products in the building.
- USE or POSSESSION of alcohol, fire arms or other weapons, or other controlled substances is strictly prohibited on city property and will result in immediate suspension and/or arrest.
- NO writing, marking, or defacing any wall, floor, or ceiling in any manner.
- NO roaming in the hallways. You must have a definite destination or activity.
- NO running in the hallways.
- SHOES must be worn at all times while in the building. (The pool area is the only exception).
- NO hard soled shoes should be worn in the gym or on the track without prior approval by the recreation department staff.
- SHIRTS are required when leaving the gym or pool area.
- ENTERING the gym or weight room with wet clothes is prohibited. For the safety of the users, this policy will be strictly enforced.
- NO public display of affection.
- NO misuse of equipment.
- CHILDREN under the age of eleven must be accompanied by and supervised by a responsible adult, unless that child is participating in a program that is organized and supervised by the recreation department.
- USING the center for personal gain or profit is prohibited.
- NO riding or parking of any type of bicycle, skateboards, or skates on any sidewalk, ramp, steps, or parking area that leads to any entrance to the building.
- RECREATION DEPARTMENT personnel will call the police to initiate state warrants on anyone who participates in a fight.
- VIOLATION of state statutes or city ordinances will result in suspension and/or prosecution.
- RECREATION DEPARTMENT or its STAFF is not responsible for lost or stolen valuables. Lockers are available for rent.
- PAY phone calls are limited to (3) minutes.
- FOOD or DRINK are available in the vending area. Food or drink is not allowed in any other part of the building without prior approval by staff.
- DUNKING on basketball rims is not permitted.
