RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DESIGNATION OF JEFFERSON CITY AS A GIG CITY BY VIRTUE OF BEING THE FIRST CITY IN JEFFERSON COUNTY TO OFFER GIGABIT HIGH SPEED BROADBAND SERVICE VIA FIBER-OPTIC CABLE TO ALL OF ITS CITIZENS THROUGH ITS PROVIDER TRILIGHT+AEC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the designation of Gig City is a "game changer", and Jefferson City is proud and honored to be leading the way.


